## PART 1 OUTLINE OF THE PROBLEM, AND RESOURCES.

1. The most likely attack appears to be from airborne enemy troops, landed on Salisbury Plain, and attempting to capture Netheravon Aerodrome.

1, R.A.F. The R.A.F. are responsible for the defence of their own serodromes at UPAVON & NETHERAVON.

For NETHERAVON. They have mobile columns each consisting of 1 section Machine Guns and 1 Rifle section at the following places—Mileball 6070

Manor Farm

2. NOME GUARD. NETHERAVON is responsible for the defence of the POST OFFICE, and for preventing the enemy from crossing the river at CHOULSTON BRIDGE & HAXON BRIDGE.

FIGHELDEAN is responsible for preventing the enemy crossing the river at Figheldean Bridge and the Ford by Figheldean House.

O P s are to be formed by the Home Guard NETHERAVON at FIFIELD FOLLY FIRHELDEAN at TUMULUS ABOVE ALTON MAGNA.

3. S.A.S. 1 BATTLE H.Q. S.A.S

2 A Mobile Column in the S.A.S consisting of 3 sections Machine Gund 1 Motor Detachment ready to operate anywhere and connected by wireless to S.A.S.

This is the minimum.
